

High School Students Compete for \$5,000! Referring Teachers May Win \$1,000

for Science and Mathematics
Projects and Papers

2015 Dr. Nelson Ying Science Competition

(Not the same as the Dr. Nelson Ying Orange County Science Exposition)

The Dr. Nelson Ying Science Competition will award \$5,000 to the winner. It will also award \$1,000 to the referring science teacher/mentor and another \$1,000 to the school to be used to enhance the school's programs. Up to four additional \$1,000 awards, based on merit, will be made to the remaining finalists. The 5 finalist students will receive an expense paid weekend in Orlando for the oral competition at the Orlando Science Center and field trips to science facilities in the Central Florida area.

The Dr. Nelson Ying Science Competition solicits science and mathematics projects and their companion papers. Eligibility is restricted to resident high school students or equivalent home school, of the OSC eight county Service Area (Brevard, Orange, Osceola, Lake, Marion, Polk, Seminole and Volusia), a letter of recommendation is required from the student's science or mathematics teacher/mentor. Topics will be limited to the Physical Sciences: Chemistry, Computer Science, Earth and Space Sciences, Engineering, Environmental Sciences, Mathematics, and Physics.

Papers are due no later than 5:00 PM, March 12, 2015. Finalists will be notified by April 9, 2015. Oral presentations will be on April 25, 2015. ISEF Rules will be followed.
