All applicants must meet minimum requirements and complete the attached Scholarship Application for Orlando Science Center Afterschool. Awarded scholarships are redeemable for one full semester of Orlando Science Center Afterschool. Scholarship awards are determined by the Orlando Science Center and consider the following criteria; family income, interest, student needs and abilities.

Eligibility:

Orlando Science Center Afterschool scholarship applicants must currently be enrolled in a grade Kindergarten through Fifth Grade and must demonstrate financial need.

Requirements:

1. Complete the OSC Scholarship Application for Orlando Science Center Afterschool.*
2. Students must answer all the questions on the application.
3. Letter of commitment written by parent.
4. Documentation must include open enrollment in Medicaid, if applicable. If Medicaid is not applicable, please provide a copy of the most recent IRS tax return for your household OR **two** of the following forms of public assistance: Medical Assistance, Food Assistance, TANF, SSI, SNAP or CHIP. All documents must be valid and active when the application is submitted. We are unable to accept pay stubs as a form of income.
5. Letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor.
6. Completed application, letters, and proof must be submitted to "OSC Afterschool Scholarship," 777 E. Princeton St., Orlando, FL 32803 as soon as possible. Limited funds available.
7. After completion of the program, scholarship recipients must complete the Scholarship Participation Survey regarding the benefits of their experience and scholarship award. Completed forms should be sent to: 777 E. Princeton St., Orlando, FL 32803. *The information will help us assess our programs and ensure future financial support from the community.*
