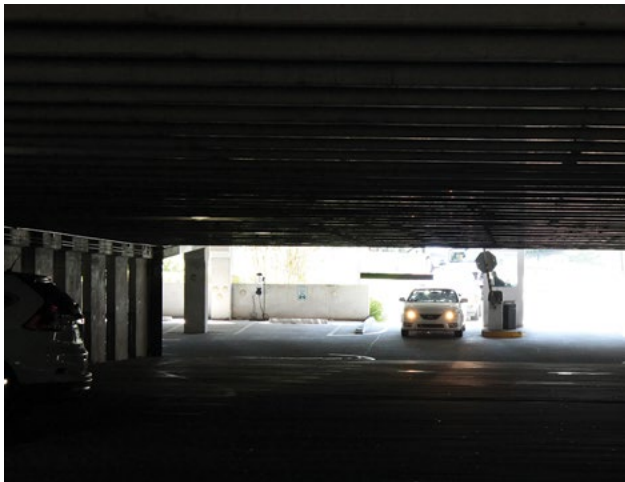

When it is our turn to go into the parking garage, we will have to stop at the gate and pay the parking attendant. The parking attendant will then raise the gate and let us in to the garage.



To enter the science center, I must cross the sky bridge on Level 2. If I am not on Level 2 I can use the elevator or stairs to get there.

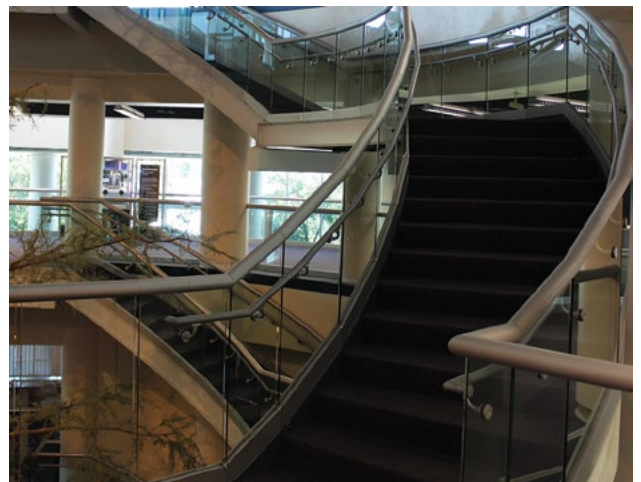

At the admissions desk I can also take a schedule that has movie times, science show times, and other scheduled activities that I can do.

If I have questions about the exhibit halls or need help at any time while I'm in the Science Center, I can ask someone who works there. People who work at the Science Center will have science center name tags.



I can visit exhibit halls on every level of the science center. I can choose to take the stairs or elevator to get to the exhibit halls on each level.

If I need a break or some quiet time, I will tell a family member or friend. There is a quiet room on Level 3 where I can take a break from the Science Center exhibit halls. People who work at the Science Center can tell us how to get there.



I can go to the bathroom anytime I need to go. I will tell my family member or friend if I need to go to the bathroom. There is a bathroom on every level across from the elevator.

While I am visiting Orlando Science Center, it is important I follow these 5 rules:

- 1** I need to stay with the family member or friend that I came with.
- 2** I cannot run.
- 3** I need to take turns with the other visitors.
- 4** If I need help or feel overwhelmed, I will tell my family member or friend.
- 5** If I am not sure whether I can touch or pick up something, I need to ask. All of the items in an exhibit hall need to stay in their exhibit hall unless someone from the Science Center says it's okay for me to take it with me.

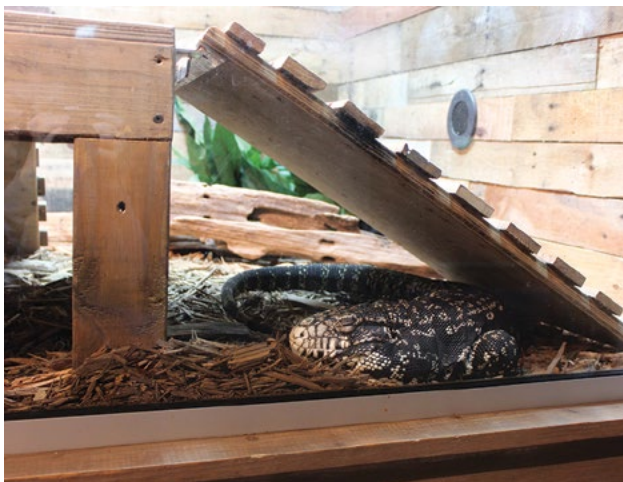
In NatureWorks there are a lot of animals I can see.
The animals will be in enclosures.



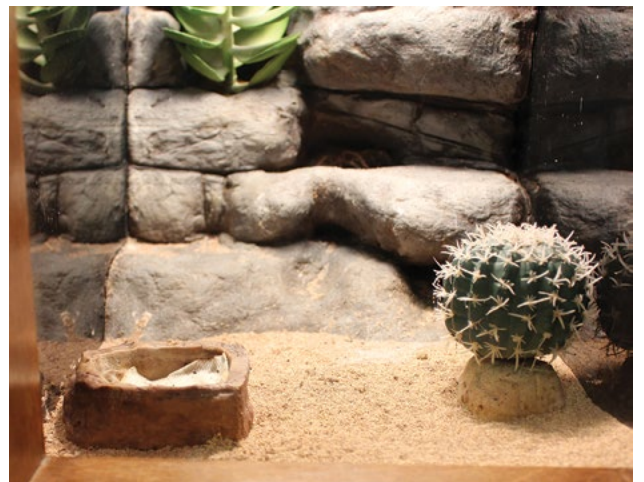
Sometimes they are by themselves and the enclosure is smaller.



Sometimes they are with other animals and the enclosure is bigger.



Some animals may be sleeping.



I may not see all the animals because some animals are hard to find.

I will not tap on the glass. That can be very loud for the animal and make it scared.



Sometimes I will be allowed to touch an animal. Many people want to touch the animal, so I may have to wait in line. When it is my turn, I will gently touch the animal.



I will only touch the animal where the staff member says it is OK to touch. After touching the animal I will get some hand sanitizer from the staff member. I need to use the hand sanitizer to make sure that I and the animals stay healthy.



If I have a question about an animal I can ask a staff member or volunteer. They will have a name tag.

There may be a lot of people in NatureWorks, so it may get loud and busy. I can leave NatureWorks at any time and I will tell my family member or friends when I'm ready to leave.

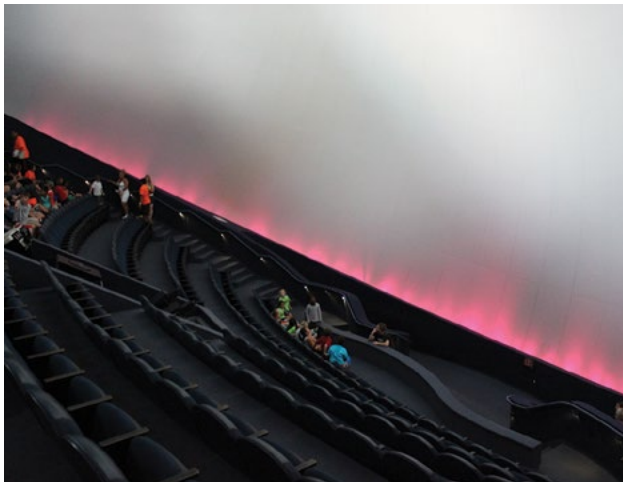

If I am seeing a movie today, I may be watching it in the CineDome. I should get to the CineDome early so I can get a good seat. Since I am early I will have to wait in line.



Inside the CineDome it will be a little dark. I will walk up the stairs and find a seat.



When the movie is about to begin the lights will go down and it will be dark. When the movie starts it may be loud.



When the movie ends the lights will come back on. I will exit by going up the stairs. I will now be on Level 3.

If I become overwhelmed I can close my eyes. I can leave the CineDome at any time and I will tell my family member or friend if I need to leave. For my safety, once I leave the CineDome I will not be allowed to go back in.





I may visit Subway where I can buy food and eat.
I will wait in line and order my food from a Subway staff member. My family member or friend can help me order.



Once I get my food I will go to a table to eat.



I can also eat outside in the park.



When I am done eating I will put my trash in the trash can. I will put the tray on top of the trash can.

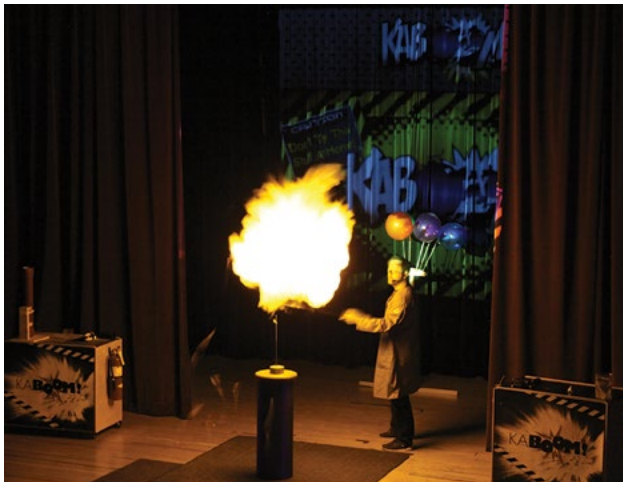
In the Digital Adventure Theater, I may be seeing a live show.

Flight Lab is in DinoDigs. If Flight Lab is open, I can try the flying simulators with my family members or friends by following directions. If I need help, I can ask my family member, friends, or Science Center staff.



I will either be the pilot or co-pilot.
The room will have low lighting.





If I am the pilot I will wear a virtual reality headset.



I will move the plane with the joystick.



If I am the co-pilot I will wear a headset. I will look at the computer screen and use the computer mouse to assist the pilot



In Our Planet there are lots of things to do.



There may be a lot of people in Our Planet, so it may get loud and busy. I can leave Our Planet at any time and I will tell my family member or friends when I'm ready to leave.

Dr. Dare's Lab is in Our Planet. If Dr. Dare's Lab is open, I can try experiments with my family members or friends by following directions. If I need help, I can ask my family member, friends, or Science Center staff.





On Level 6, I may visit the observatory. If I want to go to the observatory I should look up when it is open before I go to the science center. I can ask my family member or friend to check dates and times at www.osc.org.



To get to the observatory I will take the elevator to Level 6.



I can look through the telescopes.



I will ask my family member or friend or a staff member if I need help or have questions.

There may be a lot of people in the observatory, so it may get loud and busy. I can leave the observatory at any time and I will tell my family member or friends when I'm ready to leave.
