Pokémon Evolve – Peek at the Week

Are you ready to complete your Pokédex? Explore the amazing animals and environments that are the inspiration for Pokémon. Master the skills you'll need to create your own fantastic creatures and get ready to catch 'em all!

Monday – What's a Pokémon?: Campers will start that week by learning the basics of Pokémon! As a new Pokémon trainer, they will be making Poké balls and their trainer backpack that will be important for their adventures!

Tuesday – Inspiration for Pokémon: Did you know that Pokémon were inspired by many animals in our world? Campers will compare Pokémon to their animal counterparts. They will meet different animals that are similar to Pokémon, such as Weedle.
