Refund & Cancellation Policy

Camps may be rescheduled for a \$10.00 fee up to two times but no refunds will be processed for rescheduled camps.

Refunds will only be issued on cancellation requests made two weeks prior to the start of your camp session. A 20% processing fee is deducted from all refunds. There are no partial refunds for missed days of class.

Camp Hours

Camp hours are **9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.**

Early care starts at 7:30 a.m. Late care runs until 6:00 p.m. Early/Late care is included in the price of camp. *Please note that a late fee of \$1.50 per minute per camper applies after 6:00 p.m.*
