



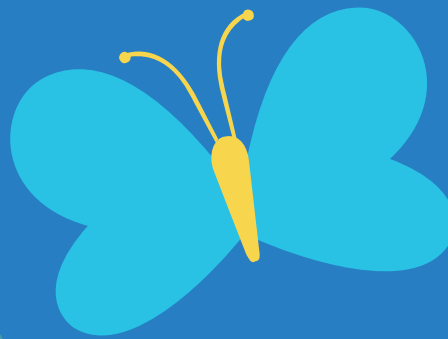

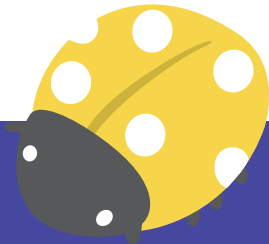
EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAMS

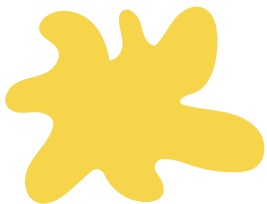
