

Addendum to OSC Offsite Contract

We are glad to continue to support STEM learning in the community. As we have new social guidelines to ensure safe behavioral practices and social distancing for your event, we would like to confirm that the following will be in place during your scheduled event.

OSC Staff will be implementing these additional procedures:

- Wellness checks for OSC Staff daily
- Cleaning and disinfecting frequently touched objects and surfaces
- Personal face masks will be used if participants are within 6 feet of the station and educator
- OSC educator will frequently clean and disinfect their hands throughout the event

Organization will need to ensure the following additional measures:

- Wellness checks for Organization's staff and participants
- Social distancing is maintained between participant groups
- The venue allows for adequate social distancing if groups are larger than 10 persons
 - Stations are set apart to allow for social distancing of participants
- Handwashing stations are available for participants and OSC staff
- Face Coverings are used if participants are within 6 feet of OSC educators

Even with these additional measures, an inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the CDC, senior citizens and visitors with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. By participating in Orlando Science Center activities, participants voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19. We cannot guarantee that individuals will not be exposed during our visit. OSC and Organization indemnify each other for any and all risks or claims arising from COVID-19 contagion. We appreciate your cooperation during this unprecedented time.

Should for some reason these guidelines not be in place or enforced, the OSC educator has the right to refuse service for the offsite program. We will contact the lead organizer to address the situation before making the determination to refuse service.
